

Copy & CD-R Service

Anyone wishing to see an item from the index should contact the Copy Service Manager. The preferred method of delivery is as electronic page images in *.jpg format. Up to 5 such images will be sent by e-mail without charge. For a larger number of images, the image files will be transferred to a CD-R which will be mailed to the user. For users unable to deal with electronic images, the Copy Service Manager will prepare paper copies of the electronic images, and mail them out. This is time-consuming, and is not encouraged. It is possible that if back-issues of **Japanese Philately** (see *Ordering Back Issues* file) or ISJP Monographs (see *Buying ISJP Publications* file) are still available, these will be less expensive for the user than paper copies of scanned images, and can probably be obtained more quickly. Aside from supplying single items on CD-R, full volumes of **Japanese Philately** can also be supplied.

By e-mail, up to 5 images, no charge.

Full remittance is required with all orders. Remittances should be made payable to ISJP, and must always be in US currency.
